

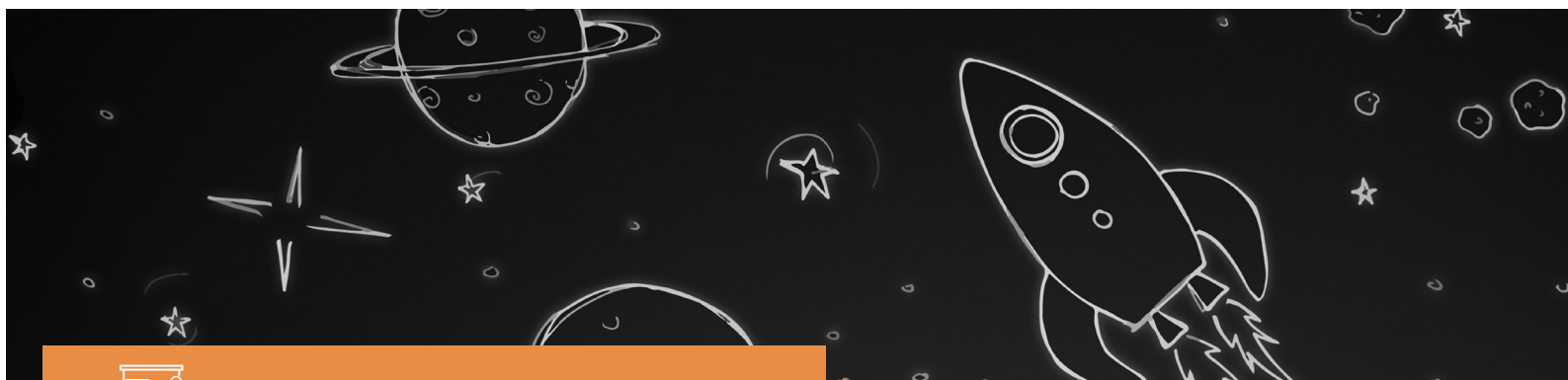

Learning outcomes

Module 1: Learners will be introduced to the scientific knowledge about the most effective and efficient ways to support and empower traumatised children.

Module 2: Learners will acquire the ability to look critically at the intervention practices and research of trauma-informed care (TIC).

Module 3: It will provide an overview of the legal framework and principles within which TIC approaches can be applied.

Module 4: As a final assignment learners will reflect on how to intervene in case of child abuse or neglect and on how to support children while ensuring children's rights are protected.

'CarePath' project is a two-year initiative which aims to improve national and regional child protection systems in providing integrated aftercare support to children ageing out of care.

The course is dedicated to people who wish to deepen their knowledge on trauma-informed practices and intervention for children in care who suffered traumatic events.
