## RESPONSE PLAN QUARTERLY REPORT: Q2 2020

In May 2020, Save the Children released a movement-wide [global response plan](#) to COVID-19, an ambitious \$649 million USD plan to reach over 69 million people in 88 countries.

We are committed to monitoring the relevance of our response to children's needs, tracking the coverage and results of our activities and learning lessons for improving response within and across countries and with other actors.

All information in this report covers from the start of the response to the end of Q2 2020.

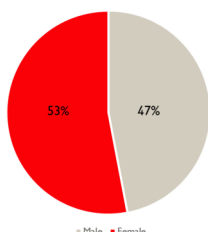

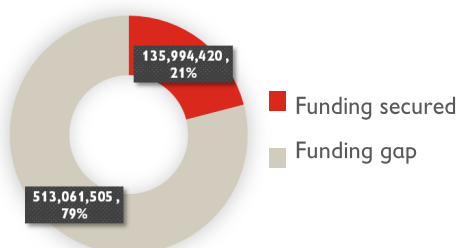

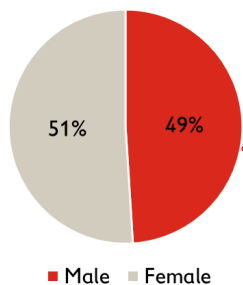

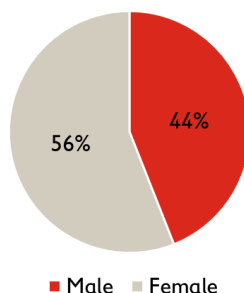

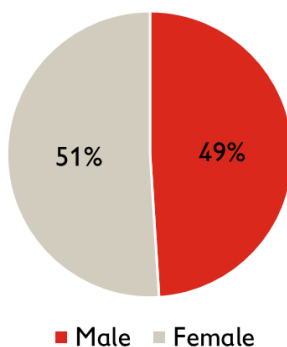

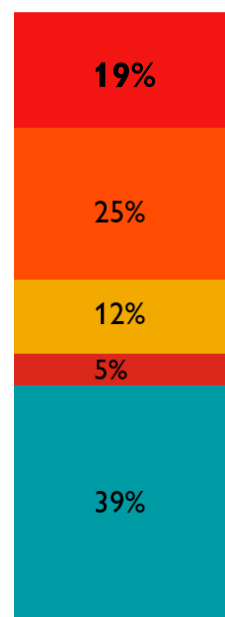

**Goal:** Children at-risk of, or experiencing, violence, exploitation, abuse and neglect have access to quality child protection services during COVID-19.

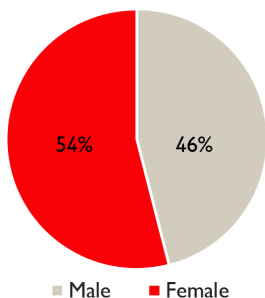

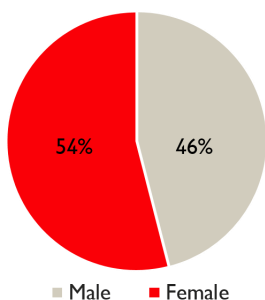

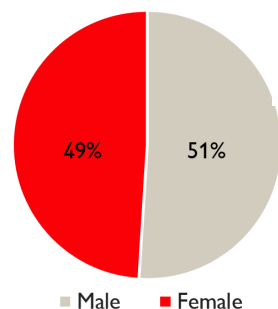

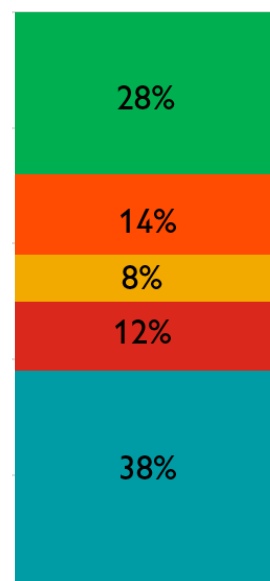

MHPSS responses by region

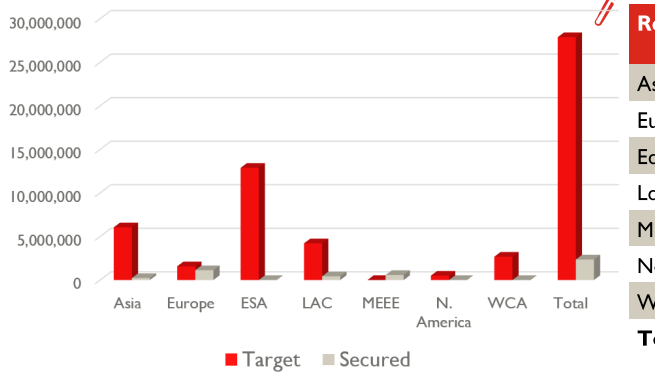
