Access to justice for children is increasingly understood as an essential building block for a sustainable future for current and future generations. In our collective efforts to achieve SDG 16, leveraging bold, ambitious, and sustainable innovations can support closing the vast justice gap for children.

This Official Side Event, Sponsored by the Permanent Mission of Sierra Leone to the United Nations, with Co-Sponsors the Permanent Missions of Canada, Luxembourg and Spain, brings together governments, multilateral organisations, civil society organisations, and children and young people themselves, for a series of solution-focused sessions. This event will profile governments' commitments, alongside effective local and national strategies that are delivering innovative policies and practices to achieve SDG 16 for children.

This Event is a multilateral call for strong partnerships and international, national and local action to deliver child-centred access to justice. It will give special attention to those children in vulnerable situations, facing the greatest adversity, and will reflect our Agenda 2030 ambitions to 'leave no one behind' and reach 'the furthest behind, first'. It also serves as a key preparatory milestone in anticipation of the 2025 World Congress on Justice With Children and informs the Committee on the Rights of the Child's development of the upcoming General Comment No. 27 on children's rights to access to justice and effective remedies.


