- 2. Academic Abstracts should adhere to the sub-theme and should include: title, problem, objectives, methodology, key findings, conclusions and recommendations
- 3. Practice Based Abstracts (Case study) should adhere to the sub-theme and should include:
 - The history / background of the situation
 - · Problem or Challenge
 - The implementation process (intervention done)
 - Conclusion should state the outcomes or lessons learnt
