Family environment and alternative care (arts. 5, 9-11, 18 (1) and (2), 20-21, 25 and 27 (4))</p> <p data-bbox="875 960 1111 984">Family environment</p> <p data-bbox="875 1019 1823 1161">46. The Committee is concerned that the disruption of family life due to poverty, armed conflict and violence has seriously weakened families’ capacities to provide a safe environment for children. It is also concerned about the prevalent stereotypes concerning the tasks and roles of women and girls, and their negative impact on the development of girls and boys.</p> <p data-bbox="875 1197 1839 1339">47. The Committee recommends that the State party invest in measures to support families’ economic self-reliance to attain the minimum conditions to provide for their children. It also recommends that the State party take measures targeting mothers and fathers to promote the equal share of responsibility for their children, in accordance with article 18(1) of the Convention.</p>

		<p>Children deprived of a family environment</p> <p>48. The Committee welcomes the State party’s measures to promote the use of foster families and family care and the development of minimum standards for care by foster families in 2015, but is concerned about the continuing extensive use of institutions which lack adequate human and financial resources.</p> <p>49. Drawing the State party’s attention to the Guidelines for the Alternative Care of Children (see General Assembly resolution 64/142, annex), the Committee recommends that the State party invest in measures to support all forms of family-based care, including through communities’ support mechanisms, and improve the human and material conditions of institutions to provide appropriate care for children under their responsibility.</p> <p>Adoption</p> <p>50. The Committee is concerned about the dissolution of the Adoption Committee.</p> <p>51. The Committee recommends that the State party re-establish the Adoption Committee and consider ratifying the Hague Convention on protection of children and cooperation in respect of intercountry adoption.</p> <p>G. Disability, basic health and welfare (arts. 6, 18 (3), 23, 24, 26, 27 (1)-(3) and 33)</p> <p>Children with disabilities</p> <p>52. The Committee takes note of act No. 00.007 on Health, Protection and Promotion of Persons with Disabilities, of December 2000, but is concerned about its lack of implementation. The Committee is particularly concerned about the majority of children with disabilities not attending school and that pervasive poverty and extensive armed violence have exacerbated the discrimination and exclusion already faced by these children and further limited their access to adequate care and assistance. It is further concerned about the increased number of children with impairments due to armed conflict.</p>
