









# Shared measurement system

- Commonly understood and mutually agreed upon benchmarks/goals
- Agreement on the ways success will be measured and reported
- Short list of common indicators
- Consistent data collection

#### Performance Monitoring Plan

#### **PREVENT**

Prevent child separation from families by scaling and supporting effective programs that link families to support systems.

#### **RESPOND**

Respond to children outside of family care via community-based models of care and support.

#### **GOVERNANCE**


Pursue systemic change through stronger profamily child protection alliances, systems, and policies.
