Specific rights (arts. 5–30)</p> <p>Children with disabilities (art. 7)</p> <p>17. The Committee is concerned about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) The absence of strategies in the National Action Plan for Children, Adolescents and their Families for the period of 2015 to 2020 to promote the best interests of the child and respect the evolving capacities of children with disabilities;(b) Reports of institutionalisation of children with disabilities and the lack of statistical data on the number of children affected by such measures;(c) Article 86 of the Family Code (1975) that allow for “moderate correction” of children, resulting in corporal punishment of children with disabilities;(d) The absence of measures to ensure that the views of children with disabilities are considered in all matters affecting their lives;(e) Allegations that the registration of newborn children with disabilities is delayed. <p>18. The Committee recommends that the State party:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(a) Strengthen measures to uphold the rights of children with disabilities, by adopting a comprehensive strategy and action plan for the promotion and protection of the rights of children with disabilities, by allocating specific human, technical and financial resources, as well as by establishing monitoring mechanisms for assessing their implementation;(b) Adopt measures for the de-institutionalisation of children with disabilities by providing them with safe alternative care in family settings and inclusive services in the community;

		<p>(c) Expedite the revision of the Family Code (1975) to explicitly prohibit corporal punishment of children in all settings, including at home and in institutions;</p> <p>(d) Take measures to develop and strengthen respect for the rights of children with disabilities in society, particularly children with disabilities living in rural areas, and enhance support for families of girls and boys with disabilities;</p> <p>(e) Set up protocols, guidelines and mechanisms in the judicial and administrative procedures and proceedings to ensure the right of children with disabilities to have their views taken into account on matters pertaining to them and their families;</p> <p>(f) Ensure that all children with disabilities are registered immediately at birth to ensure their right to have a name, to registration of their birth and to a nationality.</p>
