# The challenge – discrimination and isolation of children with disabilities in Serbia

 Placement of children with disability in large-scale institutions was common practice

Insufficient community support services to enable the social inclusion of children with disabilities

Creating family-like residential care options




# FINANCING – strategies applied


- Keeping new costs to a minimum redirecting the human and physical resources of residential care homes.


Community based services - % of municipalities covered
