2. Abstract should adhere to the sub-themes and should include :title, problem, objectives, methodology, key findings, conclusions and recommendations,
3. All abstracts should include the names of the author (s), affiliation(s), postal address, e-mail and telephone contacts. Indicate the contact author if more than one author.

Submission Guidelines for Case Study

The aim of case study presentation is to provide opportunities to share unique experiences in Child Care and Protection.

1. It should have a maximum of 350 words
2. The Case Study title should be covered in the sentence case
3. It should be submitted as word document.
4. The summary should cover the following:
 - History / background of the situation,
 - Problem or challenge
 - The implementation process (intervention done)
 - Conclusion should state the outcomes or lesson learnt.

Submission Guidelines for Documentary

The aim of documentary presentation is to share unique experiences in Child Care and Protection through audio visual.

The documentary should be self explanatory

1. The trailer should be a maximum of 3 minutes
2. The Documentary title should be displayed in the trailer
3. It should be submitted in MP4 format and not more than 15MB file size
4. The trailer should cover the following:
 - History / background of the situation,
 - Problem or challenge
 - The implementation process (intervention done)
 - Conclusion should state the outcomes or lesson learnt.
