1.0 Social Economic Security	1.1 Ratio of proportion of OVCs versus non-OVCs in households living below the poverty line.		
2.0 Food and Nutrition Security	2.1 Ratio of proportion of OVCs versus non-OVCs who are malnourished (underweight) (C2); 2.2 Ratio of food insecure households with OVCs compared to households without OVCs (A1).		
3.0 Care and Support	3.1 Ratio of OVCs versus non-OVCs who have three minimum basic material needs for personal care (C1) 3.2 % OVC whose households received free basic external support in caring for the child (C5). 3.3 % OVC who live under the protection of an adult care-giver.		
4.0 Mitigating the Impact of conflict	4.0 % of Children affected by conflict/ displacement accessing essential services		

SPPO2: To deliver integrated and equitably distributed essential services to OVC and their households that are of sufficient quality	
5: Education	5.1 Ratio of proportion of OVCs versus non-OVCs aged 10-14 years who are currently attending school (C6).
6. Psychosocial Support	6.1 % OVC 6 – 17 years participating in peer group activities; <i>Special studies:</i> 6.2 Ratio of proportion of OVC versus non-OVCs aged 12-17 with an adequate score for psychological health (A2); 6.3 Ratio of proportion of OVCs versus non-OVCs aged 12-17 who have a positive connection with the adult they live with most of the time (A3)
7. Health	7.1 Ratio of proportion of OVCs 12-24 months versus non-OVCs 12-24 months who are fully immunized.
SPPO3: To strengthen the legal, Policy and institutional frameworks for programme that seek to protect OVC and households at all level	
8. Child Protection	8.1 Ratio of proportion of OVCs versus non-OVCs aged 15-17 who had sex before age 15 years. (C3) 8.2 Proportion of children under 5 years whose births are reported registered (C7).
SPPO4: To enhance the capacity of households, other implementing agents and agencies to deliver integrated, equitable and quality services for OVC and households
